This can be used as an inspiration to the children to keep their surroundings clean. 14. <u>Visit the School</u> – Along with the School administration, organize Sports Day with different Sports/Games for different age groups. 15. <u>Visit the School</u> – After spending the day in the schools, filling in as teachers (to balance the deficit in teaching staff), go with the children to their homes (i.e., the slum area) to experience their lives& understand how Jagriti has made a difference. 	<p>15 Day Model +</p> <p><i>This week is the final week of the Volunteering Program and is thus focused on the administration process, office end work etc.</i></p> <p><i>The volunteers can be instructed to lookup various fundraising options, Contact prospecting Donors, Promote Jagriti on various Social Media Platforms and share their suggestions/ideas/improvements for the same.</i></p> <p><i>Another important task that can be performed in this week figuring out ways to get more and more children living in slums enroll in Jagriti Schools.</i></p>

Notes:

- a. Office days are Italicized and Field Work Days have 'Visit the School' written in front of advised activity.
- b. This program is so planned so that the volunteers working for a longer time get a wholesome experience, but at the same time, those volunteering for a shorter time also get an understanding of how things work.
- c. The long-term volunteers should be notified about the major participative events that will come their way during the course of their collaboration with Jagriti (Example: organizing the sports day (end of 10 Day Model), visit to the slum (end of 15 Day Model)) in the beginning itself.
- d. As can be noticed, during the course of the 20 Day Model, the volunteers are asked for ideas/suggestions/improvement twice, this is so they can assess their own growth as a result of the 20 days they spent volunteering with Jagriti & give Jagriti some useful, economic and feasible ideas.

IMPORTANT: The school so picked for the duration of the volunteering program must not change.
